

## TRAINING TOPIC TODAY – 4.19.2020: THE ROLE OF A DISPATCHER

## 1. INDEPENDENT FREIGHT DISPATCHER – WHO FINDS AN OWNER OPERATOR WITH THEIR OWN MC AUTHORITY AND YOU AS THE DISPATCHER FIND LOAD AND BOOK LOADS FOR THEM ("Glorified Brokers")

- Still have to find carriers (Dispatcher Agreement and Profile)

- Finding loads (Load Boards and Direct Relationships with Brokers/Shippers)

- Booking the Load (Carrier Packet/Broker-Carrier Agreement (W9, COI, MC Authority and NOA) and Rate Confirmation)

- Invoice carrier for our percentage (Dispatchers need to be paid for their service)

2. <u>DISPATCHER STARTS A TRUCKING COMPANY WITH OWN MC AUTHORITY (BUT NO ASSETS)</u> – <u>YOU WOULD</u> <u>LEASE YOUR AUTHORITY TO OWNER OPERATORS WHO DO NOT HAVE AN AUTHORITY AND SIMPLY DISPATCH FOR</u> <u>THEM</u>

- Still have to find carriers (By having them agree to lease under my authority)

- Finding loads (Load Boards and Direct Brokers/Shippers)

- Booking the Load (Carrier Packet/Broker-Carrier Agreement (W9, COI, MC Authority and NOA) and Rate Confirmation)

- Invoice factoring through your factoring company which can be automated based off of your conditions

## 3. DISPATCHER STARTS A TRUCKING COMPANY WITH OWN AUTHORITY AND ASSETS (TRACTORS AND TRAILERS) - IN THIS CASE, YOU WOULD SIMPLY DISPATCH FOR YOUR COMPANY DRIVERS

- Hire company drivers

- Finding loads (Load Boards, Brokers, and Shippers)

- Booking the Load (Carrier Packet/Broker-Carrier Agreement (W9, COI, MC Authority and NOA) and Rate Confirmation)

- Invoice factoring through your factoring company which can be automated based off of your conditions
